THE FISHERIES (LABORATORIES FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2012

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Laboratories Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2012 and shall be read as one with the Fisheries (Laboratories Fees) Regulations, 2012 hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations".

THE FISHERIES (LABORATORY FEES) REGULATIONS, 2012
